- Week games start @6:00 no inning will begin after 8:30P.M at the umpire's discretion .
 - Sunday doubleheaders begin @ 2:00 PM. The first game has a 2 hour time limit excluding delays because of weather. No inning will begin after 2 hours but must be completed if home team is behind.
 - Prior to the game, a team may opt to bat all the players. The Umpire and the opposing team should be informed.
 - Ten run rule is in effect for the league.
 - There is a no jewelry rule.
 - A starter may re-enter after being substituted for as long as the batting order is not changed. Now the "sub" may also re-enter in the same spot in the batting order. The switch between "starter" and "subs" may continue throughout the game as long as the batting order is not affected.
 - An EH can be used for regular season only and must be decided on prior to the start of the game both teams do not have to use an EH.
 - If a team starts with 10 or more (EH) and injury or ejection occurs you shrink lineup not an out in that slot in the lineup. Teams must start with minimum 9 and finish with 9.
 - Coaches are responsible for all properly equipped players and equipment including bats.
 - The bat may not exceed 34" in length, and the bat barrel may not exceed 2 5/8" in diameter. All aluminum/alloy barrel bats and all composite handle (only) aluminum/alloy barrels are allowed. Only "composite barrel" bats certified and marked BBCOR .50 will be allowed. Wooden bats shall be 1 piece 2 3/4 at the thickest part and not to exceed 42" in length.
 - Any player, manager or coach warming up the pitcher at home plate shall wear a mask, ANYWHERE ON SITE.. It is recommended anyone warming up a pitcher at any location should wear a mask. A throat protector is considered part of the catcher's mask.
 - Babe Ruth is the only league that does NOT require coaches to wear helmets while coaching the bases, and it is the only league that DOES force coaches to wear masks while warming up a pitcher.
 - Please remember that Babe Ruth utilizes MLB rules (ie: Balks are live...etc.)
 - Umpire Fee for Tri-County is \$65 per game (no travel stipend).
